# Haitham bin Tariq Al Said appointed as the new ruler of Oman

Haitham bin Tariq Al Said (66) was appointed as the new ruler of the Oman after the death of Sultan Qaboos bin Said Al Said who ruled the country from 1970. Haritham bin Tariq Al Said who is the cousin of the deceased Sultan Qaboos, was the Cultural and Heritage Minister of Oman. In 2013 he was appointed by the Sultan Qaboos to chair the main committee responsible for Oman's development.

# Tsai Ing-wen won the Taiwan Presidential Election

Taiwan's President Tsai Ing-wen has won the presidential election for second time with 57.1% of total votes. She belongs to Democratic Progressive Party (DPP). She defeated Han Kuo-yu of the rival Nationalist Party. In 2016 she won the Presidential election for the first time.

# Jasprit Bumrah gets BCCI's Polly Umrigar Award

Indian Bowler Jasprit Bumrah will receive the Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI)'s Polly Umrigar Award for his super performance in International cricket. At the same time, Poonam Yadav clinched the top prize in women's category and was awarded the best international cricketer.
