India and Israel launch commemorative logo to mark 30th anniversary of establishment of diplomatic ties

- India and Israel have launched a commemorative logo on January 24, 2022 to mark the 30th anniversary of the establishment of diplomatic ties between the two countries.
- The logo was unveiled jointly by Ambassador of Israel to India Naor Gilon and Indian envoy to Israel, Sanjeev Singla thorugh virtual mode.
- The logo features the respective symbols of the national flags of both countries, that is Ashoka Chakra and the Star of David.
- The symbols forms the numeral 30 depicting the 30th anniversary of bilateral relations.
- The diplomatic relations between Israel and India was established on 29 January 1992.

Health Minister Mansukh Mandaviya launches revamped website and Mobile App "MyCGHS" of Central Government Health Scheme

- The Union Health Minister Mansukh Mandaviya launched the revamped website and mobile app of the Central Government Health Scheme (CGHS) on January 24, 2022.
- The website is www.cghs.gov.in and the mobile app is called "MyCGHS".
- The new features will benefit more than 40 lakh beneficiaries with real-time information from the convenience of their homes.
- The website has been made 3U compliant, where u stands for Usable, User-Centric and Universally Accessible.

CSCs launches Yogyata mobile app to impart skill-based vocational education to rural youths

- The Common Services Centers (CSC) has launched a mobile phone application named "Yogyata" to impart vocational education and skill enhancement opportunities to youth and citizens in rural areas.
- Through this Yogyata App, CSCs aims to provide industry-based skills to youth in rural areas and thereby make them job-ready.
- The enrolments under the app will be carried out by the Village Level Entrepreneurs (VLE).

Spices Board of India launches 'Spice Xchange India', country's first online platform for spice exports

- The Union Minister of State for Commerce and Industry Som Parkash inaugurated India's first portal for spice exports named 'Spice Xchange India' at a hybrid event held in Kochi.
- The spicexchangeindia.com portal has been launched by the Spices Board of India.
- The portal is a 3D virtual platform, that makes use of artificial intelligence (AI)-based technology to connect India's spice exporters with buyers from around the world.

AIIB Commits USD 150 million investment in Data Center Development to Serve Emerging Asia

- The Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) has committed to invest USD150 million in the development of data centers that mostly serve Emerging Asia.
- The Beijing-based multilateral development bank, AIIB, will invest the fund through the **Keppel Data Centre Fund II (KDCF II).**
- This is the first data center project investment by AIIB.
- KDFC II is a closed-end private equity vehicle managed by **Singapore-based financial** institution, Alpha Investment Partners Limited (Alpha).

Indian film Koozhangal wins Best Film Award at 20th Dhaka International Film Festival 2022

- The Oscar-nominated Tamil film 'Koozhangal', has bagged the Best Film Award in the Asian Film Competition category at the Dhaka International Film Festival 2022.
- The film has been directed by P S Vinothraj. Famous South Indian actress Nayanthara and her husband Vignesh Shivan are the producer of the film.
- Meanwhile, Malayalam actor **Jayasurya won the Best Actor** award in the Asian Competition for the movie 'Sunny'. The film is directed by Ranjith Shankar.

Assam Confers 'Assam Baibhav' Award To Industrialist Ratan Tata

- The state government of Assam has conferred its highest civilian award 'Assam Baibhav' for the year 2021 on industrialist and philanthropist Ratan Tata.
- Mr Tata has been awarded for "his exceptional contribution towards furthering cancer care in Assam".
- The award was presented by Assam Governor Jagdish Mukhi on January 24, 2022.
- Assam Baibhav is the highest civilian award in the State of Assam

• The award carries a cash prize of **Rs.5 lakh** (US\$6,600).

- The **President of Armenia, Armen Sarkissian** has announced his resignation on 23 January 2022.
- As per Sarkissian, his office is not granted sufficient powers to allow him to be an effective head of state.
- Armen Sarkissian served as the **4th president** of Armenia from 9 April 2018 to 23 January 2022.
- He had also served as Prime Minister of Armenia from 4 November 1996 to 20 March 1997.

India is Celebrating 73rd Republic Day on 26 January 2022

- India is observing the **73rd Republic Day on 26 January 2022.**
- Republic Day marks the date on which the **Constitution of India came into effect on 26 January 1950.**
- It replaced the Government of India Act (1935) as the governing document of India.
- Every year, on Republic Day, the President of India gives away Padma Awards to the civilians of India.
- Padma Awards are given in three categories **Padma Vibhushan, Padma Bhushan and Padma Shri**, in decreasing order of importance.

International Customs Day: 26 January

- The International Customs Day (ICD) is observed on 26 January every year.
- Objective of the day is to recognise the role of customs officials and agencies and focus on the working conditions and challenges that customs officers face in their jobs.
- Theme 2022: "Customs Digital Transformation by Embracing a Data Culture and Building a Data Ecosystem.".
- The day was instituted by the **World Customs Organization** (WCO) to commemorate the day in 1953 when the inaugural session of the Customs Cooperation Council (CCC) was held in Brussels, Belgium.
- In 1994 the CCC was renamed World Customs Organization (WCO).

Meity releases Vision Document 2.0 titled 'USD 300 billion electronics manufacturing powerhouse by 2026'

- The **Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY)** released a 5-year roadmap and Vision Document 2.0 for the electronics sector on January 24, 2022
- The Vision Document 2.0 titled **"\$300 bn Sustainable Electronics Manufacturing &** Exports by 2026" has been prepared by MeitY in association with the India Cellular & Electronics Association (ICEA).
- It is the second volume of a two-part Vision Document.
- The first part of the document titled "Increasing India's Electronics Exports and Share in GVCs" was released in November 2021.
- Vision Document 2.0 provides a year-wise break-up and production projections for the various products. This will help India to transform into a US\$300 billion electronics manufacturing powerhouse by 2026, from the current US\$75 billion.

128 People Conferred with Padma Awards 2022

• The Padma Awards are one of the highest civilian Awards in India. They are conferred in three categories namely, Padma Vibhushan, Padma Bhushan and Padma Shri.

- The awards are announced every year on the occasion of Republic Day on January 26, in various disciplines/ fields of activities, such as art, social work, public affairs, science and engineering, trade and industry, medicine, literature and education, sports, civil service, etc. .
- The 2022 Padma Award has been conferred upon **128 winners.**
- These includes four Padma Vibhushan, 17 Padma Bhushan awardees, and 107 Padma Shri awardees.
- 34 out of 128 awardees are women, while ten persons are Indian origin and Non-Resident Indians.

President approves 384 Gallantry Awards for 2022

- The **President of India Shri Ram Nath Kovind has approved 384 Gallantry awards** to Armed Forces personnel and others on the eve of 73rd Republic Day celebrations, on January 25, 2022.
- Apart from this, the **President's Police Medals have been conferred on 939 awardees**, including 189 Gallantry Medals, 88 Police Medals for Distinguished Service and 662 medals for Meritorious Service.

IMF lowers India's FY22 growth forecast to 9% from 9.5%

- The International Monetary Fund (IMF) has cut India's economic growth forecast for the current fiscal 2021-22 (FY22) to 9 percent, in its latest world economic outlook report, released on January 25, 2022.
- Earlier this was estimated at 9.5%
- IMF has projected the growth forecast for India in 2022-23 (FY23) at 7.1%
- IMF has projected the global growth rate in 2022 to 4.4%, and in 2023 to 3.8%.

Apple retained the title as world's valuable brand in Brand Finance 2022 Global 500

- **Apple** has retained its position as the **most valuable brand in 2022** as well, according to the Brand Finance 2022 Global 500 report.
- The brand valuation of Apple was recorded at \$355.1 billion in 2022, which is an increase of 35% from last year.
- This is the highest brand value ever recorded in the Brand Finance Global 500 ranking history.
- Other brands in top 10 are
 - Amazon, Google, Microsoft, Walmart, Samsung, Facebook, Industrial and Commercial Bank of China, Huawei and Verizon respectively.

• Top Indian brand

- The Indian conglomerate **Tata Group** emerged as the most valuable brand from India and also in South Asia. It is only brand from the country in the top 100.
- Global Rank 78
- Brand value US\$23.9 billion.

India ranks 85th in Corruption Perceptions Index (CPI) 2021; Top- Denmark, Finland, NZ

- Transparency International has released the Corruption Perceptions Index (CPI) 2021 in which India has been ranked at 85th spot (Score of 40).
- The ranking has been topped jointly by three countries- Denmark, Finland and New Zealand. (Score of 88)
- This ranking measures how corrupt each country's public sector is perceived to be. The results are given on a scale of 0 (highly corrupt) to 100 (very clean).
- 180 countries are ranked in it.
- Last year (for 2020) India was ranked 86th with a score of 40.
- This year's Corruption Perceptions Index (CPI) reveals that corruption levels are at a **worldwide standstill.** The **global average** remains unchanged for the tenth year in a row, **at just 43** out of 100 points.

Western Naval Command conducts Joint maritime exercise Paschim Lehar (XPL-2022)

- Western Naval Command of the Indian Navy conducted a joint maritime exercise Paschim Lehar (XPL-2022) off the West Coast which concluded on January 25, 2022.
- The exercise continued for 20 days and was conducted with an aim to enhance Inter-Service synergy among the Indian Navy, IAF, Indian Army and Coast Guard.
- The Western Naval Command (HQ- Mumbai) is one of the three command-level formations of the Indian Navy. Other two are Eastern Naval Command (HQ- Visakhapatnam) and Southern Naval Command (HQ- Kochi)

Russia-China-Iran conducts joint naval exercise CHIRU-2Q22 in Gulf of Oman

- The Russian, Chinese and Iranian navies undertook naval exercises CHIRU-2Q22 in the Gulf of Oman from January 18 to 22, 2022.
- The maritime drills conducted in the northern parts of the Indian Ocean aimed at deepening practical cooperation among the navies of the three countries.
- The participants practiced various tactics and operations, such as rescuing ablaze vessels, saving hijacked vessels, shooting at targets, nocturnal shooting at aerial targets, and other tactical maneuvers as a part of the drill.

Russia delivers 70,000 AK-203 assault rifles to India

- **Russia** delivered all the contracted **70,000 AK-203 Kalashnikov assault rifles** to the Indian Armed Forces on January 25, 2022.
- The Indian Armed Forces had placed an order for **670,000 rifles**, for which the contract was signed on December 06, 2021 between India and Kalashnikov (Russian defense manufacturing unit).
- The total cost of the contract is around **Rs 5,124 crore.**
- The contract included procuring 70,000 rifles off the shelf.
- The remaining 600,000 rifles will be manufactured by an Indo-Russian joint venture company, Indo-Russia Rifles Private Limited (IRRPL), based at Amethi, Uttar Pradesh India under transfer of technology (ToT). [at Korwa Rifle Factory, Amethi]
- The lightweight AK-203 Rifles will replace military's in-service INSAS (Indian Small Arms System) Rifle.



- International Day of Commemoration in memory of the victims of the Holocaust (International Holocaust Remembrance Day) is observed on 27 January every year since 2006.
- The theme of the International Holocaust Remembrance Day 2022 is "Memory, Dignity • and Justice"
- The objective of the day is to commemorate the anniversary of the tragedy of the Holocaust that occurred during the Second World War.
- A genocide occurred during World War II in which Nazi Germany, aided by its collaborators, systematically murdered some six million European Jews, around twothirds of the Jewish population of Europe, between 1941 and 1945.
- United Nations designated the day in 2005 to serve as a date for official commemoration of the victims of the Nazi regime and to promote Holocaust education throughout the world.

Govt notifies Certification Scheme for Unmanned Aircraft Systems (Drones)- to boost indigenous manufacturing

- The Government of India has notified the Certification Scheme for Unmanned • Aircraft Systems (UAS) commonly known as Drones to ensure minimum safety and quality requirements of drones.
- It was notified on January 26, 2022 and it will boost indigenous manufacturing of Drones. It has been notified under Rule 7 of the liberalized Drone Rules, 2021, which replaced Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS) 2021.
- The Government of India has formulated the **Digital Sky Platform** for registration and operation of drones with an all-digital process. These initiatives like Certification Scheme, PLI (production-linked incentive) Scheme, Liberalised drone rules, airspace map and DigitalSky Platform, will help the drone manufacturing industries in India.
- Ministry of Civil Aviation in September 2021 had approved a PLI scheme for drones and drone components with an allocation of Rs 120 crore spread over three financial years.

PM Narendra Modi Hosts First India-Central Asia Virtual Summit

- Prime Minister of India Shri Narendra Modi hosted the first India-Central Asia **Summit** on 27 January 2022, through virtual platform.
- It was the first of its kind engagement between India and the Central Asian countries at the level of leaders.
- Central Asian region has five recognized countries. These are the Republic of Kazakhstan, Kyrgyz Republic (Kyrgyzstan), Republic of Tajikistan, Turkmenistan and Republic of Uzbekistan.
- The Summit was attended by the Presidents of these five Central Asian countries. •
- The first India-Central Asia Summit coincided with the **30th anniversary** of • establishment of diplomatic relations between India and Central Asian countries.
- During the summit, the Leaders agreed to hold the Summit every 2 years (biennial).

Tata Group Officially takes over Air India Operations

- The Government of India officially handed over India's flag carrier, Air India to Talace Private Limited, a subsidiary of Tata Group, on January 27, 2022, almost 69 years after acquiring the conglomerate.
- The total value of the deal is **Rs 18,000 crore (US\$2.4 billion).**
- The strategic disinvestment transaction of Air India includes transfer of 100 percent stake of GoI in Air India to Tata Sons, along with management control.
- The transaction covers three entities namely, Air India, Air India Express and Air India SATS (AI SATS).
- Under the deal, Tata group will also be handed over Air India Express and 50 percent stake in ground handling arm AI SATS.

MoS Culture Meenakashi Lekhi launches pictorial comic book 'India's Women Unsung Heroes'

- The Union Minister of State for Culture Meenakashi Lekhi has released a pictorial comic book titled 'India's Women Unsung Heroes', as a tribute to the forgotten women freedom fighters of the country.
- The book has been prepared by the **Ministry of Culture** in partnership with **Amar Chitra Katha**, an Indian publisher of Indian comics and graphic novels..
- The book portrays the stories and tales of valour of queens who battled imperialism & dedicated their lives for Maa Bharati (Mother Earth).

Former Indian Hockey Team Captain Charanjit Singh Passes Away at 90

- The former **Hockey mid-fielder Charanjit Singh** has passed away at his residence in Una, Himachal Pradesh, after suffering a cardiac arrest and prolonged age-related illnesses. He was 90.
- Charanjit Singh was the **Captain** of the Indian hockey team which won **gold** in the **Tokyo Olympics of 1964**,
- He was also a member of the Indian team which won silver medals in the 1960 Games in Rome, and in the 1962 Asian Games at Jakarta.

Veteran Marathi author and social activist Anil Awachat passes away at 77

- Renowned Marathi author and social activist Anil Awachat has passed away due to a prolonged illness.
- He was 77.
- Dr Awachat was the founder of a de-addiction center called Muktangan Rehabilitation Center in Pune in 1986.
- He was known for his several Marathi books like "Manasa", Swatahavishayi, "Gard", "Karyarat", "Karyamagna" and "Kutuhalapoti".

Padma Shri awardee Kathakali artist Milena Salvini passes away at 84

- Noted **Kathakali dancer Milena Salvini from France**, known for teaching Indian classical dance, has passed away. She was 84.
- Salvini was born in Italy but moved to France for learning music.

- In 1975 she opened the Mandapa Centre in Paris to teach Indian classical dance.
