Amit Shah flags off Delhi-Katra Vande Bharat Express

Air India Launches "Namaskar Sewa" For Passengers At Delhi Airport

National carrier Air India has started "Namaskar Sewa" at Delhi airport to provide better services to the passengers. "Namaskar Sewa" is a meet-and-greet service through which Air India staff will take care of its passengers from the airport entry gate till the passengers board the aircraft. The airline will charge passengers for this service. "For Namaskar sewa, we have fixed nominal charges for domestic passengers - Rs. 750 and for international passengers, it will Rs. 1,500,". Rajasthan Bans Certain Categories of Pan Masala to Curb Addiction Among Youth

All such products will now be banned in the state under the Food Safety Act.. Rajasthan has become the third state after Maharashtra and Bihar to announce such a move.
