Bangladesh bans Islamist outfit 'Allar Dol'

Government of Bangladesh has banned the Islamist outfit 'Allar Dol' saying that it poses threat to public safety and security.

Allahr Dol is the ninth Islamist group to be banned for extremism and militancy in Bangladesh. Allah'r Dol was formed in 1995 with the aim to establish Caliphate through armed struggle. In 2004 it merged with banned militant organisation Jama'atul Mujahideen Bangladesh (JMB).

First ever'BIMSTEC Ports' Conclave'

The Minister of State (I/C) for Shipping,Shri Mansukh Mandaviya inaugurated the first ever'BIMSTEC Ports' Conclave'at Visakhapatnam in Andhra Pradesh on 7 November 2019. MoU between India and Paraguay


