RBI keeps repo rate unchanged at 4%

The Reserve Bank of India in its Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) meet held between February 3-5, 2021 has kept the policy rates unchanged as under:

- 1. Policy Repo Rate- 4.00%
- 2. Reverse Repo Rate- 3.35%
- 3. Marginal Standing Facility Rate- 4.25%
- 4. Bank Rate- 4.25%
- 5. CRR-3%
- 6. SLR-18.00%

The MPC continued to maintain the accommodative stance. The MPC has predicted the economic growth rate i.e. GDP growth rate of India at 10.5 percent in 2021-22 (FY22)

Andaman and Nicobar Islands becomes first Union Territory to become corona free



The Andaman and Nicobar Islands has become the first Union territory in India among all the states and UTs to officially become free of the Covid-19 infection, as per the data by Ministry of Health.

This means that the number of active cases in the island has come down to zero. The A&D Island had reported a total of 4,932 cases and 62 deaths from the virus. The last four infected persons in Andaman and Nicobar Islands have been declared cured.

World's First 'Energy Island' to be built by Denmark in North Sea



The Government of **Denmark** has approved a project to build the **world's first energy island**, in the **North Sea** that will produce and store enough green energy to meet the electricity needs of **three** million households in European countries.

The first-of-its-kind giant island will be as big as 18

football pitches (120,000sq m).

The estimated cost of the project is around 210bn kroner (£24bn; €28bn: \$34bn) and is the biggest construction project in Danish history.

The artificial island will be linked to hundreds of offshore wind turbines and will supply power to households well as green hydrogen for use in shipping, aviation, industry and heavy transport.

Paypal to shut domestic payments service in India from April 1

PayPal was a payments options on many Indian online apps such as travel and ticketing service MakeMyTrip, online film booking app BookMyShow, and food delivery app Swiggy.

HAL to develop world's first high-altitude pseudo satellite that can fly unmanned for upto 3 months

The **Hindustan Aeronautics Limited** (HAL) is developing a futuristic **high** altitude pseudo satellite with a start-up company, to strengthen the country's military strike capabilities.

It is a first of its kind project in the world, where a manned aircraft will operate within the boundary and the unmanned aircraft will enter the enemy zone and can carry out strikes deep inside the enemy territory.

The high altitude pseudo satellite will be solar energised and the unmanned object will fly around 70,000 ft for 2-3 months to take information.

The technology has been named **Combined Air Teaming System (CATS).** It will have a manned aircraft (will be known as **mother ship**), operating from faraway, and four autonomous unmanned aerial vehicle known as **CATS Warrior.**

Joe Biden's Son Hunter Biden to Release Memoir 'Beautiful Things' in April 2021


