The Prime Minister of India Shri Narendra Modi inaugurated the second 'Maritime India Summit 2021' through video conferencing on March 02, 2021. The Summit will conclude on March 04, 2021.As a part of the event, the Sagar-Manthan: Mercantile Marine Domain Awareness Centre and e-book of maritime

vision 2030 was also launched. Ministers from eight nations, over 50 global CEOs and more than 160 speakers which include 115 international speakers from 24 nations are participating in the three-day Summit

Key Points to Remember:

- Sagar-Manthan: Mercantile Marine Domain Awareness Centre is an information system for enhancing maritime safety, search and rescue capabilities, security and marine environment protection.
- The e-book of maritime vision 2030 aims to make the Indian maritime industry at par with the top global benchmark in the next 10 years.
- The Government of India aims to operationalise 23 waterways by 2030.
- The **Sagarmala Programme** was announced by the Government in 2016 for promoting port led development and enhance the performance of the country's logistics sector.

India to Send Humanitarian Assistance To Drought-Hit Madagascar onboard Indian Naval Ship Jalashwa



The Government of India is sending food and medical assistance to Madagascar, following the request from the east African country for assistance to deal with a humanitarian crisis caused by a severe drought. The humanitarian assistance is

being delivered on-board Indian Naval Ship Jalashwa. The Naval ship will leave with the food and medical assistance on March 3, 2021 and is expected to reach the **Port of Ehoala in Madagascar** between March 21 and 24, 2021. The consignment will comprise of 1,000 metric tonnes of rice and 100,000 hydroxychloroquine (HCQ) tablets.

Lok Sabha TV and Rajya Sabha TV merged into one single entity called Sansad TV



The **Rajya Sabha and Lok Sabha Television** channels that broadcast the proceedings of the upper and lower Houses of Parliament, respectively, have been merged into a single entity. The new channel has been named as the 'Sansad Television' .This change is effective

from March 01, 2021. Ravi Capoor, a retired IAS officer of the 1986 batch, has been appointed as the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of Sansad TV for one year. The decision to change the name was jointly taken by Rajya Sabha Chairman M. Venkaiah Naidu and Lok Sabha Speaker Om Birla.

Indian Air Force to Participate in EX Desert FLAG VI



For the first time ever, the Indian Air Force (IAF) is participating in Exercise Desert Flag-VI, which has been organised from March 03 to 27, 2021 at Al-Dhafra airbase, UAE.Ex Desert Flag is an annual multi-national large force employment warfare exercise hosted by the United Arab Emirates Air

Force. The exercise will also see the air forces of United Arab Emirates, United States of America, France, Saudi Arabia, South Korea and **Bahrain.** The IAF is participating with six Su-30 MKI, two C-17 and one IL-78 tanker aircraft.Purpose: provides operational exposure to the participating forces, train them to undertake simulated air combat operations in a controlled environment, provides an opportunity to enhance their operational capabilities along with mutual exchange of best practices.

In shooting, the Indian trio of Mairaj Ahmed Khan, Angad Vir Singh Bajwa and Gurjoat Khangura won the bronze medal in men's skeet team event at the International Shooting Sport Federation tournament (ISSF) Shotgun World Cup in Cairo, Egypt. The Indians defeated the Kazakhstan team of David Pochivalov, Eduard Yechshenko and Alexandr Mukhamediyev 6-2 in the bronze medal match.
