Hyderabad-based Maithri Aquatech sets up 'World's First Mobile Water from Air Kiosk' at Vizag Smart City



Hyderabad-based startup, Maithri Aquatech has set up the world's first mobile water from air kiosk and water knowledge centre in the smart city of Visakhapatnam, in Andhra Pradesh. This innovative water kiosk is such that the potable water is harvested from the air instead of depending on scarce groundwater and surface water

resources. This initiative is supported by Greater Visakhapatnam Municipal Corporation and project SEWAH (Sustainable Enterprises for Water and Health), an alliance between USAID and SWN (Safe Water Network). The kiosk will provide clean, mineral-enriched potable water harvested from the air by making use of Maithri Aquatech's own Meghdoot solution as a source to generate water. Apart from this, the kiosk will also function as a Water Knowledge Resource Centre by creating awareness and imparting necessary information to members of the local underserved communities as well as nearby schools on the benefits of good water, sanitation and hygiene (WASH) practices.

India tops the medals tally with 15 gold, 9 silver & 6 bronze in 2021 Delhi ISSF Shooting World Cup

India finished at the top of the medals table at the 2021 ISSF World Cup New Delhi, held from 18 to 29 March 2021 at the Dr. Karni Singh Shooting Range in New Delhi. India secured 30 medals which included 15 gold, 9 silver and 6 bronze.

USA came second with eight medals including four gold, three silver and one bronze.

New Zealand becomes only second country after India to pass Miscarriages Bereavement Leave Law



The New Zealand Parliament has recently passed legislation to provide leave for miscarriage and for stillbirth. The Bill allows mothers and their partners the right to paid leave following a miscarriage or still birth, without having to tap into sick leave.

Employees will get three days leave when a pregnancy ends with a stillbirth. With this, New Zealand has become **only the second**

country in the world to do so.India is the only other country in the world with similar legislation that provides leave for miscarriage and stillbirth.

Indian Navy to participate in French Naval Exercise in Bay of Bengal with QUAD nation

Uttarakhand Ranger Mahinder Giri Wins International Ranger Award 2021



Mahinder Giri, a range officer at Rajaji Tiger Reserve in Uttarakhand has been honored with the prestigious International Ranger Award for his contribution towards conservation. He is the only ranger from Asia to win the prize. A total of 10 professionals from across the world have been awarded the International Ranger Award for 2021. All the winners will receive a uniform patch and their employing

organisations will receive US \$10,000 (Rs 7,26,150) as prize money, which can be used to support the winner and their team to conduct their work. International Ranger Award was created in 2020 through a collaboration between the International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN) – World Commission on Protected Areas (WCPA), the International Ranger Federation, Global Wildlife Conservation, and Conservation Allies.

Thisara Perera becomes first Sri Lankan to hit six Sixes in an Over



Sri Lankan all-rounder Thisara Perera has become the first cricketer from the island nation to hit six sixes from one over. He achieved the feat on March 28, 2021 during a domestic match in Colombo while playing for Army Sports Cricket Club in List A match against Bloomfield Cricket and Athletic Club. He scored an unbeaten 52 runs

from 13-ball, and thus smashing the second-fastest half-century in List A cricket.
