Birth Anniversary of Mahatma Jyotiba Phule

The Prime Minister has paid tribute to the great social reformer, philosopher and writer Mahatma Jyotiba Phule on his birth anniversary.



About Mahatma Jyotiba Phule Jyotirao Govindrao Phule was an Indian writer, social activist, thinker and anti-caste social reformer from Maharashtra.Personal Life:He was born in the Satara district of Maharashtra in 1827.His father, Govindrao was a vegetable vendor at Poona. Jyotirao's family belonged to the 'mali' caste and their original title was 'Gorhay'.Malis were considered as an inferior caste by the Brahmins and were shunned socially.He was influenced by Thomas Paine's book titled The Rights of Man and believed that the only solution to

combat the social evils was the **enlightenment of women** and members of the **lower caste**s.Phule was also a merchant, author as well as a municipal council member.In 1863, one of his businesses was to supply metal-casting equipment to construction sites. He was appointed commissioner to the Poona municipality and served in the position until 1883.

Savitribai Phule

- 1831 Born in Naigaon, Satara district in a poor peasant family.
- 1840 Married to Jotiba Phule.
- 1841 Jotiba began to educate her.
- 1848 -Became the first female teacher in the first school for girls in Pune.
- 1848 -Started school for adult learners in Usman Shaikh's wada.
- 1852 Awarded the Ideal Teacher Award by the School Inspection Committee.
- 1853 Started Foundling home for children of widows.
- **1854** -Published first collection of poems Kavya Phule, making her the first modern poetess of Marathi.
- 1855 -Began teaching in a school for peasants and workers.
- **1890** -Jotiba Phule died; opposition to his last rites by adopted son, Savtribai , led the funeral.
- 1897 -19th March Savitribai died of plague

What is Alternative Dispute Resolution?

ADR refers to the **methods of resolving a dispute**, which are alternatives for **litigation in Courts**.Generally, it uses a **neutral third party** who helps the parties to communicate, discuss the differences and resolve the dispute.It **offers to resolve all types of matters** related to civil disputes, as explicitly provided by the law.It is capable of providing a **substitute for the conventional methods** of resolving disputes.

The EPRS is the upgraded version of the Pinaka variant, which has been in service with the Indian Army for the last decade. The rocket system has been upgraded with advanced technologies and enhanced range to meet the emerging requirements. The Pinaka rocket system has been developed by DRDO lab- Armament Research and Development Establishment, Pune in collaboration with High Energy Materials Research Laboratory, Pune.

RBI releases Guidelines on Establishment of Digital Banking Units (DBUs)

In the Union Budget 2022-23, the government of India announced the setting up of **75 Digital Banking Units (DBUs) in 75 districts to commemorate the 75 years of independence of our country (Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav).** To achieve this objective, the Reserve Bank of India has

released the guidelines on the establishment of Digital Banking Units (DBUs).

Digital Banking Unit (DBU): It will be a specialised fixed point business unit / hub housing certain minimum digital infrastructure for delivering digital banking products & services as well as servicing existing financial products & services digitally, in both self-service and assisted mode for a minimum of 4 hours per day for at least five days a week.

Which Banks can open Digital Banking Unit? – Scheduled Commercial Banks (other than RRBs, Payments Bank and Local Area Banks) with past digital banking experience are permitted to open DBUs in Tier 1 to Tier 6 centres.

IFSCA inks MoU with World Bank promoted GVFL Limited for strengthening the FinTech ecosystem in GIFT IFSC

India wins first-ever gold medal at WSF World Doubles Squash championships

The second seeded Indian duo **Dipika Pallikal Karthik and Saurav Ghosal** won the **mixed double title** at 2022 WSF World Doubles Squash championship at Glasglow on April 09, 2022. The Indian duo thrashed the fourth seeded pair of Adrian Waller and Alison Waters of England in the mixed doubles finals in straight sets 11-6, 11-8. Apart from this, **Dipika and Joshna Chinappa** paired to win **women's doubles final**, 11-9, 4-11, 11-8 defeating England's Sarah Jane Perry and Waters. Meanwhile, England's Declan James and James Willstrop beat Scotland's Greg Lobban and Rory Stewart, 11-10; 11-6, to win men's doubles final. This is the first gold medal for India at WSF World Doubles Squash championship, which the country had never won before this.

World Homeopathy Day 2022: 10 April
