Around 5000 Konyak women dance to set a Guinness World Record at Mon, **Nagaland**

On 8th April 2019, in the programme organized at Mon (Nagaland) during the Aoleang Monyu festival (usually held between 1st April to 3rd April every year) around 5000 Konyak Naga women in their traditional attire attempted to set a Guinness World Record for the 'Largest Traditional Konyak Dance'.

The theme of the Aoleang Monyu festival aka Mini Hornbill festival was 'Empowering women for cultural heritage.'

Key points

i. It has been given this certificate for providing passenger amenities in a clean and green environment.

ii. ISO certification received by Guwahati Railway Station is ISO-14001, which is for Environment Management System as per international norms which were upgraded in 2015.

Key Points:

i. The previous record holder was **53 years** old **Uruguayan Robert Carmona** who was played a professional match in 2015.

ii. Hayik was born in Iraq and immigrated to Israel with his parents. He was officially recognized in an award ceremony attended by representatives from

the Guinness World Record organization.
