

Chhattisgarh's first Anti-Naxal Women's Commando unit deployed

The Chhattisgarh police has deployed first ever Anti-Naxal women's commando unit named **'Danteshwari Ladake'** or **'Fighters of Goddess Danteshwari'**. These women commandos have inducted in the District Reserve Guard (DRG) which is Chhattisgarh's frontline anti-naxal force.
