Rs. 20,050 cr PMMSY detailed by Giriraj Singh: Fish production target set to 220 LMT by FY24-25



₹20,050 crores for Fishermen through Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) Union Minister for Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Giriraj Singh detailed the **Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana** (PMMSY) during a press conference in New Delhi.**i.**It will be implemented for a

period of **5 years** i.e. from **FY 2020-21 to FY 2024-25** in all states and Union Territories (UTs).

**ii.**PMMSY is dedicated to the fishers, fish farmers, fish workers, fish vendors and other stakeholders associated with the fisheries sector.

iii.Importantly, the scheme is providing insurance coverage for fishing vessels, which is being introduced for the first time.

**iv.**A booklet on PMMSY was also released during the conference. Bring **Blue Revolution** through sustainable and responsible development of fisheries sector in India.

-To double export earnings to **Rs.1,00,000 crore**.

- -Generation of about **55 lakhs** direct and indirect employment opportunities in fisheries sector.
- -To increase aquaculture average productivity to **5 tons per hectare** from the current national average of 3 tons per hectare.
- -To reduce post-harvest losses from the present 25% to about **10%** by modernizing and strengthening the value chain.

#### **Current status of India in fisheries sector:**

- **1**.India is the 2nd largest aquaculture and 4th largest fish exporting nation in the world.
- **2**.It constituted 7.73% of the global fish production and export earnings of Rs.46,589 Crores (2018-19).

**3**.The sector recorded an Average Annual Growth Rate of 10.88% during 2014-15 to 2018-19, 7.53% average annual growth in fish production and 9.71% average annual growth in export earnings, with 18% share in agricultural exports.

Taiwan President Tsai Ing-wen re-elected for second term; 2 Indian MPs sent congratulatory video messages

63-years-old Tsai Ing-wen, the current and first female President of Taiwan has been re-elected for a second four-year term of presidency. A representative of **Democratic Progressive Party (DPP)**, took the oath on May 20, 2020.



i.Under Tsai Ing-Wen presidency, Taiwan has tackled the COVID-19 pandemic successfully as the nation has confirmed just 440 cases and 7 deaths. It has recorded no new cases since May 7, 2020 and has not seen a locally transmitted case since April 12, 2020. ii.Apart from video recordings, there was also a virtual

ceremony which was attended by **Sohang Sen**, the acting director general of the India Taipei Association from India.

'Hunar Haat', the flagship initiative by the Minority Affairs Ministry,


will make a comeback in September 2020 with a 'Local to Global' theme.

# WFIRST Telescope of NASA renamed after 'Mother of Hubble' Nancy Grace Roman



US Space agency NASA has announced to name its next-generation space telescop, the Wide Field Infrared Survey Telescope (WFIRST), currently under development, in honor of Nancy Grace Roman, NASA's first chief astronomer, who paved the

way for space telescopes focused on the broader universe.

The WFIRST Telescope will now be called Nancy Grace Roman Space Telescope (or Roman Space Telescope, for short). It is set to be launched in the mid-2020s.


**Dr. Nancy Roman is considered as the Mother of NASA's Hubble Space Telescope**, which was launched 30 years ago. It was because of Nancy Grace Roman's leadership and vision that NASA became a pioneer in astrophysics and launched Hubble, the world's most powerful and productive space telescope The Roman Space Telescope will investigate long-standing astronomical mysteries, such as the force behind the universe's expansion, and search for distant planets beyond our solar system.

It will be the successor to NASA's Hubble and Webb Telescopes.

### SBI Research Downgrades India's GDP at -6.8% for FY21

SBI Research has slashed India's economic growth forecast in the current fiscal year 2020-21 to contract to 6.8 percent from earlier 4.7 percent. This means, as per SBI Research Report, India's GDP is estimated at -6.8% in FY21.

# JK Rowling releases her new work 'The Ickabog' online for free for Children during COVID-19



The "Harry Potter" author, J.K. Rowling has released her new children's story "The Ickabog" which will be published online for free, for the children during this lockdown period. The Ickabog' is a story about truth and the abuse of power.

The first two chapters of "The Ickabog" was released on a new website on 26 May 2020. The author will post the chapters (two or three at a time) every weekend over the next seven weeks. Rowling has pledged to donate all royalties when the book is published to "groups who've been particularly impacted by the pandemic."
