Major Highlights of the meeting

i. NAM Leaders assessed the impact of COVID-19, identified needs and requirements for possible remedies and urged action-oriented follow-up measures ii. Following the summit, the leaders **adopted a Declaration underlining the importance of international solidarity in the fight against COVID-19.**

iii. Leaders announced the creation of **a 'Task Force'** to identify needs and requirements of member states through the establishment of a common database reflecting their basic medical, social and humanitarian needs in the fight against COVID-19.

About NAM:

i.It was found in **1961** by initiatives of Gamal Abdel Nasser of Egypt, Kwame Nkrumah of Ghana, Jawaharlal Nehru of India, Ahmed Sukarno of Indonesia and Josip Broz Tito of Yugoslavia & **has 120 member states**, 17 Observer Countries and 10 Observer organizations.

ii. The basic concept for the group originated in 1955 during the Bandung Conference held in Indonesia, "Ten Principles of Bandung", was proclaimed in the conference which was later adopted as the main goals and objectives of the policy of NAM

iii. The 1st NAM Summit Conference was held in Cairo, Egypt from 5-12 June 1961.

will provide an opportunity for India to emerge as an economic powerpost COVID-19.

It should be noted that the northeast consists of 60% of India's reserve of Bamboo.

Also the govt. amended the 100 year old Indian Forest Act, 1927 brought in 2017, as a result of which, home grown bamboo has been exempted from it in order to enhance livelihood opportunities through bamboo.

DRDO Develops "UV blaster", Ultraviolet Disinfection Tower



The Laser Science & Technology Centre(LASTEC), Delhi-based, laboratory of the Defence Research and Development Organisation(DRDO), Defence ministry with the assistance of New Age Instruments and Material Private Ltd., Gurugram developed "UV blaster" an ultraviolet(UV) disinfection tower for a quick and chemical-free sanitization of areas that are highly prone to the infection of novel coronavirus in method.

Features of UV Blaster

1. The disinfection tower can be used remotely through laptop or mobile phone using a WIFI link.

2. The device is effective for disinfecting areas having large flow of people such as airports, shopping malls, metros, hotels, factories, offices, etc.

3. The disinfection time for a room of about 12×12 feet dimension will be about 10 minutes.

4.A 400-square-foot area can be sanitized within 30 minutes if the device is positioned at different places within the room.

2020 Pulitzer Prizes announced: 3 photojournalists from Jammu & Kashmir won the feature photography

The 2020 Pulitzer Prize winners were announced in 15 Journalism categories and 7 Book, Drama and Music categories by its administrator, Dana Canedy, via video-conference instead of a ceremony at Columbia University in New York, United States (US) due to the coronavirus pandemic for their "striking images of life" in the valley.



Three Indian photographers Dar Yasin, Mukhtar Khan, and Channi Anand, from the Associated Press, have been awarded the 2020 Pulitzer Prize Journalism in Feature for Photography category.

They have been awarded for their outstanding coverage of the lockdown in Jammu and Kashmir in August 2019, after Article 370 was revoked, and all lines of communications were snapped.

The Pulitzer Prize is an award given for outstanding achievements in newspaper, magazine and online journalism, literature, and musical composition by Columbia University in the United States.

DBS Bank projects India's GDP for FY21 at 1%

DBS Bank has cut India's FY21 GDP forecast to 1% as against 1.5% as predicted earlier. This projection is based on the assumption of an end in the lockdown in the June quarter, reopening of all sectors by third quarter (October-December).

Egypt tennis player Youssef Hossam banned for life on match-fixing charges

Egyptian professional tennis player Youssef Hossam has been banned from professional tennis for life for match-fixing, as per the official notification by the Tennis Integrity Unit on 4 May 2020. Hossam has been found guilty of 21 breaches of the Tennis Anti-Coprruption Program from 2015 to 2019.

50.37 lakh people internally displaced in India in 2019: UNICEF

More than five million people (50,37,000) were internally displaced in India due to natural disasters, conflict and violence in 2019 as per "The Lost at Home' report", published by the UN Children's Fund (UNICEF).

India has the highest number of new internal displacements in the world in 2019. Philippines, Bangladesh and China are on 2nd, 3rd and 4th spot respectively. The report is about the risks and challenges for internally displaced children and the urgent actions needed to protect them
