Global Day of Parents: 01 June

The Day was proclaimed by United Nations in 2012.

The 2021 Global Day of Parents theme is 'Appreciate all parents throughout the world'

World Milk Day: 01 June

World Milk Day is observed on June 1 each year to recognize the importance of milk as a global food and provide an opportunity to bring attention to activities that are connected with the dairy sector.

The international day was established by the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) of the United Nations in 2001.

The theme of 2021 is 'Sustainability in the Dairy Sector'.

OECD Projects India Growth Forecast For FY22 To 9.9%; Global Economy to Rebound at 5.8%

The Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) has cut the growth projection for India to 9.9% in financial year 2021-22 (FY22), from its previous estimate of 12.6%.

Downward revision is due to the second wave of coronavirus infections that has paused economic recovery in the country.

However, OECD has revised upward the GDP growth projection for **global economy**, and now expects it to grow at **5.8 % in 2021**, compared with 4.2% projected in December.

GST Council Forms 8-member GoM under Meghalaya CM Conrad K Sangma to examine GST exemption on Covid material

The Goods and Services Tax (GST) Council has constituted a Group of Ministers (GoM) to examine Goods and Services Tax (GST) exemptions on a range of Covid-19 relief materials such as vaccines, drugs, testing kits and ventilators

The eight-member ministerial panel will be headed by Meghalaya Chief Minister Conrad K Sangma.

Currently, 5% GST is levied on domestically manufactured vaccines, and 12% GST for COVID drugs and oxygen concentrators.

Pooja Rani Wins 75kg Gold for India in 2021 Asian Amateur Boxing Championships

India's Pooja Rani won the gold medal in the 75kg Women's Middle category final at the 2021 Asian Amateur Boxing Championships, in Dubai, on May 30, 2021.

She was the lone Indian woman boxer to strike gold at the 2021 Asian Championships.

Indian women secured overall ten medals, including one gold, three silver and six bronze.

PM Modi announces Rs 10 Lakh PM CARES Fund for kids orphaned due to COVID

Prime Minister Narendra Modi has announced a number of welfare measures for children who lost their parents to COVID-19.

The welfare measures have been listed below:

Fixed Deposit in the name of the child

- Government has announced "PM-CARES for Children" scheme under which fixed deposits will be opened in the names of such children from the PM-CARES fund.
- The total corpus of fund will be Rs 10 lakh for each child.
- This corpus will be used to give a monthly financial support/ stipend when the child reaches **18 years of age**, for the next five years to take care of his or her personal requirements.
- Upon reaching the age of **23 years**, the child will get the corpus amount as one lump sum for personal and professional use.

Education

- Children under 10 years will be given admission in the nearest Kendriya Vidyalaya or in a private school as a day scholar.
- Children between 11-18 years of age will be given admission in any central government residential school such as Sainik School and Navodaya Vidyalaya.
- For higher education, children will be assisted in obtaining education loan for professional courses or higher education in India according to existing norms. The interest on this loan will be paid from the PM-CARES fund.

Health Insurance

- Each child will be enrolled as a beneficiary under Ayushman Bharat Scheme (PM-JAY) with a health insurance cover of **Rs 5 lakh.**
- The premium amount for these children will be paid by PM CARES, till they attain age of **18 years**.

National Security Advisor Shri Ajit Doval Commissions Indian Coast Guard Offshore Patrol Vessel Sajag

National Security Advisor Shri Ajit Doval dedicated to the nation, the Indian Coast Guard (ICG) Offshore Patrol Vessel (OPV) Sajag digitally on May 29, 2021.

Sajag is the **third in a series of five offshore patrol vessels** indigenously designed and constructed by **M/s Goa Shipyard Limited.**





The ship is fitted with advanced technology equipment, weapon and sensors capable to carry a twin engine helicopter and four high speed boats.

OPV Sajag will enable ICG to undertake various operations within and beyond Indian Ocean Region (IOR) for safeguarding the maritime interests.

Decorated historian and author **Vikram Sampath** has come out with the second and concluding volume of the book on the life and works of Veer Savarkar titled "Savarkar: A contested Legacy (1924-1966)".

The book will hit the stands on July 26, 2021, under the publication of Penguin Random House India.

The first volume, "Savarkar: Echoes from a Forgotten Past" was released in 2019 and covered Savarkar"s life from his birth in 1883 to his conditional release from prison in 1924.

The second volume will bring to light the life and works of Vinayak Damodar Savarkar, from 1924 to 1966, the year he died.





Mary Kom Settles with Silver Medal at 2021 Asian Boxing Championships

Indian pugilist Mary Kom, lost to two-time world champion Nazym Kyzaibay of Kazakhstan, to settle for silver medal at the 2021 ASBC Asian Boxing Championships in Dubai on May 30, 2021.

The five-time Asian Championships gold medallist Mary Kom was competing in high-octane 51kg final.

This is the second silver for Mary Kom at the Asian Championships who has previously won silver in 2008.

Apart from this, she won world championship titles on five occasions including 2003, 2005, 2010, 2012, and 2017.

Chelsea Beats Manchester City 1–0 to Win 2020-21 UEFA Champions League Final

Chelsea defeated Manchester City 1–0 in the final, to lift 2020-21 UEFA Champions League title, on May 29, 2021, played at the Estádio do Dragão in Porto, Portugal.

German forward Kai Havertz scored the only goal of the football match.

This is the **second Champions League title for Chelsea**, after winning the first won in 2012

World No-Tobacco Day: 31 May

World No Tobacco Day (WNTD) is observed every year on 31 May, globally to inform the public on the dangers of using tobacco and to discourage the use of tobacco in any form.

Theme of the 2021 WNTD is "Commit to quit."
