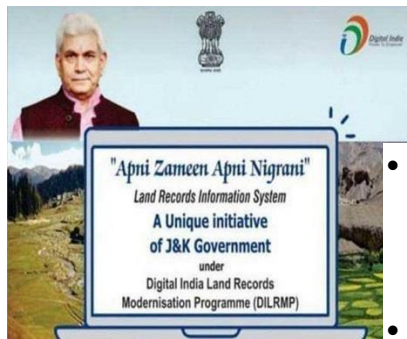


AAPKI ZAMEEN AAPKI NIGRANI (AZAN)

In Jammu and Kashmir, the Union Territory Administration is running a unique programme to enhance transparency in the land records maintenance system.



About:

- The initiative - 'Aapki Zameen Aapki Nigrani' (AZAN) - is aimed at facilitating easy online access to the system to view or monitor the status of revenue records.
- Citizens no longer need to visit the offices for obtaining information about their land. AZAN has empowered them to check their land records on CIS Portal - <http://landrecords.jk.gov.in/>.
- The initiative is part of the Digital India Land Records Modernisation Programme (DILRMP).

WORLD BLOOD DONOR DAY

World Blood Donor Day is observed every year on 14th of June with an aim to raise awareness of the need for safe blood and blood products for transfusion and also to thank voluntary, unpaid blood donors for their life-saving gifts of blood.



About:

- The slogan for this year is 'Donating blood is an act of solidarity. Join the effort and save lives'.
- World Blood Donor Day marks the Birth Anniversary of Karl Landsteiner, who first distinguished human blood into A, B, AB and O groups.
- As per the World Health Organization, blood donation by one per cent of the population is generally the bare minimum for meeting a nation's most basic blood needs. According to available data, India fell short of the WHO standard by 1.9 million units or 15 per cent.

BHARAT GAURAV TRAIN

The first service of the theme-based Bharat Gaurav Train from Coimbatore North to Sainagar Shirdi started its journey on 14-06-2022.



About:

- With this, Southern Railway becomes the first zone in Indian Railways to get the first Registered service provider under the ‘Bharat Gaurav’ Scheme and commence the operations of the maiden service from Coimbatore North to Sainagar Shirdi.
- Indian Railways had launched the operation of theme-based Bharat Gaurav train in the month of November 2021.
- The objective of this theme is to showcase India’s rich cultural heritage and magnificent historical places to the people of India and the world, through Bharat Gaurav Trains.
- This scheme also aims to leverage the core strengths of the professionals of the tourism sector to run theme-based trains to tap the vast tourist potential of India.

BEAR MARKET (MARKET SLUMP)

Wall Street opened the week with heavy losses that put the benchmark S&P 500 at a level considered to be a so-called bear market.

- Rising interest rates, high inflation, the war in Ukraine and a slowdown in China’s economy have led investors to reconsider what they’re willing to pay for a wide range of stocks, from high-flying tech companies to traditional automakers.
- A bear market is a term used by Wall Street when an index like the S&P 500, the Dow Jones Industrial Average, or even an individual stock, has fallen 20% or more from a recent high for a sustained period of time.
