

IOC formally opens \$145M new headquarters in Switzerland

The International Olympic Committee has formally opened its 145 million Swiss francs (\$145 million) new headquarters in Lausanne, Switzerland exactly 125 years after the Olympic Games was revived.

Roger Federer wins his 10th Halle Open title

World number three Roger Federer defeated David Goffin 7-6(7-2), 6-1 in the final to win the Halle Open for the 10th time. It is the first time that the 37-year-old has won the same title 10 times in his career.

Milan-Cortina to host Winter Olympics 2026

Italian cities Milan and Cortina will host the Olympic Winter Games 2026. International Olympic Committee elected the Italian cities at the 134th IOC Session, taking place from June 24 to 26, in Lausanne.
