Based on the 'SMART' policing concept 'SMART' — strict and sensitive, modern and mobile, alert and accountable, reliable and responsive, techno-savvy and trained The Quality Council of India (QCI), which executed the survey, assessed 87 shortlisted police stations across the country on a number of parameters like performance in controlling crime, infrastructure of the police building, mess and optimal use of technology, and citizen feedback.

IOA and FIH chief Batra elected IOC member Indian Olympic Association president Narinder Batra was elected as a member of the International Olympic Committee.
