India pledges to contribute USD 5 million in 2019 to UN Palestine refugee agency

India has pledged to contribute 5 million US Dollars in 2019 to the UN Palestine refugee agency. The Government has increased its annual financial contribution fourfold to the UNRWA core budget, from 1.25 million dollars in 2016 to 5 million in 2018

He succeeds Anupam Shrivastava who retired upon superannuation on June 30, 2019

Morgan Stanley India's GDP at 6.2% in 2019 and 7.1% in 2020

America based Investment Bank, Morgan Stanley has predicted the GDP growth rate for India at 6.2% in 2019 and 7.1% in 2020. For 2018 it was 7.4%. Morgan Stanley has also cut the global growth estimate at 3% and 3.2%t for 2019 and 2020
