PM Narendra Modi unfurls Tricolour at Red Fort as India celebrates 75th Independence Day



Prime Minister of India, Shri Narendra Modi unfurled the Tricolour at the historic Red Fort in New Delhi, to mark the **75th Independence Day of India** on August 15, 2021. While PM Modi hoisted the National Flag, flower petals were showered at the venue by two Mi 17 1V helicopters of the Indian Air Force in Amrit Formation. This

is the first time ever during the celebrations that flower showering ceremony was held. The 75th year of Independence is being celebrated as 'Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav'. The celebrations will continue till August 15, 2023.

PM Modi sets India's target to become 'energy independent' by 2047

For this, PM has announced a 'Mission Circular Economy' that will replace petroleum with other forms of energy to make India achieve self-reliance in energy production by 2047. would include a mix of electric mobility, gas-based economy, doping ethanol in petrol and making the country a hub for hydrogen production. Modi government has decided to set up the National Hydrogen Mission to make India a new global hub and the exporter of green hydrogen.

75 Vande Bharat Express trains will connect every corner of country in 75 weeks of 'Amrit Mahotsav'



Prime Minister Narendra Modi addressed the nation on the occasion of 75th Independence Day on August 15, 2021 and announced that 75 'Vande Bharat' trains would connect different parts of the country in 75 weeks of the celebration of Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav. The 75 Vande Bharat trains will connect every corner of the country, in 75 weeks of the 'Azadi ka

Amrit Mahotsav', which is being celebrated from March 12, 2021, upto August 15, 2023. Presently two Vande Bharat Express trains are operating in the country by the Indian Railways. The first Vande Bharat Express operates between Varanasi and New Delhi and the other Vande Bharat Express operates between Katra and New Delhi.

Union Minister Dr. Virendra Kumar flags off 'Operation Blue Freedom' to create a World Record at Siachen Glacier



The Union Minister for Social Justice and Empowerment Dr. Virendra Kumar flagged off a pioneering world record expedition named 'Operation Blue Freedom' from Dr. Ambedkar International Centre, New Delhi on the occasion of 75th Independence Day on August 15, 2021. The Operation Blue Freedom expedition comprise of

a team of people with disabilities from across the country to reach Siachen Glacier, to create a new World Record, for the largest team of people with disabilities reaching the world's highest battlefield. The team of people with disabilities were trained by 'Team CLAW', a team of Armed Forces veterans.

Chhattisgarh gets 4 new districts to take total administrative districts to 32



Chhattisgarh Chief Minister Bhupesh Baghel has announced the creation of four new districts and 18 new tehsils in the state. The four new districts are: Mohla Manpur, Sarangarh-Bilaigarh, Shakti, Manendragarh. With the creation of four new districts, the total number of administrative districts in the state have reached 32. Apart from this, a garden will be

developed exclusively for women in every district headquarter and the municipal corporation of the state, which will be known as the "Minimata Udyan".

Afghanistan Prez Ashraf Ghani steps down, as Taliban forces takes power

It is India's first Cattle Genomic Chip for the conservation of pure varieties of indigenous cattle breeds like, Gir, Kankrej, Sahiwal, Ongole etc.IndiGau chip has been developed by scientists of National Institute of Animal Biotechnology (NAIB), Hyderabad, an autonomous institution under the aegis of the Department of Biotechnology. The chip will help in achieving the goal of conservation of our own breeds with

better characters and help towards doubling farmers' income by 2022.

Four more wetlands from India have been added to the list of Ramsar sites, giving it the status of 'Wetland of International Importance'. These sites are:

Haryana 4.Bhindawas, Haryana

With this, the total number of Ramsar sites in India have reached 46, covering a surface area of 1,083,322 hectares.
