Bihar gets Centre's nod for Kosi-Mechi river interlinking

The Centre has approved the Rs 4,900 crore project for interlinking of Kosi and Mechi rivers of Bihar. This is the second major river interlinking project in the country to be approved after the Ken-Betwa project in Madhya Pradesh. Bihar has got the final remaining mandatory technoadministrative approval for the project from the. Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC). The central government has approved construction of 76.20 km canals on eastern bank of Kosi for irrigation purpose. The project will prevent recurring floods in north Bihar and also irrigate over 2.14 lakh hectares of cultivable land in Bihar.

He Started his 22 mile journey at 715 am from Sangatte, Northern France and landed at Saint Margaret's bay in Dover in around 25 minutes. Franky Zapata made his first attempt to cross the English Channel on 25th July but failed as he fell into the water half-way when he tried to land on a boat for refueling.
